## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Labor and Secretary of Energy to submit a report to Congress on occupations and career paths affected by changes in energy production and critical manufacturing.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Workforce Solutions  
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON WORKFORCE.**

2 Beginning not later than 180 days after the date of  
3 enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Labor and the Sec-  
4 retary of Energy shall, jointly, submit to Congress, on an  
5 annual basis, an economic analysis of occupations and ca-  
6 reer paths impacted by changes in the energy and critical  
7 manufacturing industries, including information on—

8 (1) growth;

9 (2) entry-level occupations;

10 (3) pre-requisites for occupations;

11 (4) living wage salaries;

12 (5) career paths;

13 (6) barriers that prevent individuals in under-  
14 served communities from acquiring employment in  
15 new occupations and career paths in such industries;

16 and

17 (7) how digital technology advancements are  
18 impacting the critical manufacturing industry.
