# **A BILL**

To provide for the addition of certain real property to the reservation of the Siletz Tribe in the State of Oregon.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE; CLARIFICATION.**

4       *(a) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this Act is to facilitate*  
5 *fee-to-trust applications for the Siletz Tribe within the geo-*  
6 *graphic area specified in the amendment made by this Act.*

7       *(b) CLARIFICATION.—Except as specifically provided*  
8 *otherwise by this Act or the amendment made by this Act,*  
9 *nothing in this Act or the amendment made by this Act,*  
10 *shall prioritize for any purpose the claims of any federally-*  
11 *recognized Indian tribe over the claims of any other feder-*  
12 *ally-recognized Indian tribe.*

13 **SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OF THE SILETZ**  
14 **TRIBE OF THE STATE OF OREGON.**

15       *Section 7 of the Siletz Tribe Indian Restoration Act*  
16 *(25 U.S.C. 711e) is amended by adding at the end the fol-*  
17 *lowing:*

18       “(f) *TREATMENT OF CERTAIN PROPERTY.—*

19               “(1) *IN GENERAL.—*

20                       “(A) *TITLE.—The Secretary may accept*  
21 *title to any additional number of acres of real*  
22 *property located within the boundaries of the*  
23 *original 1855 Siletz Coast Reservation estab-*  
24 *lished by Executive Order dated November 9,*  
25 *1855, comprised of land within the political*

1           *boundaries of Benton, Douglas, Lane, Lincoln,*  
2           *Tillamook, and Yamhill Counties in the State of*  
3           *Oregon, if that real property is conveyed or oth-*  
4           *erwise transferred to the United States by or on*  
5           *behalf of the tribe.*

6           “(B) *TRUST.*—*Land to which title is ac-*  
7           *cepted by the Secretary under this paragraph*  
8           *shall be held in trust by the United States for the*  
9           *benefit of the tribe.*

10          “(2) *TREATMENT AS PART OF RESERVATION.*—  
11          *All real property that is taken into trust under para-*  
12          *graph (1) shall—*

13                 “(A) *be considered and evaluated as an on-*  
14                 *reservation acquisition under part 151.10 of title*  
15                 *25, Code of Federal Regulations (or successor*  
16                 *regulations); and*

17                 “(B) *become part of the reservation of the*  
18                 *tribe.*

19          “(3) *PROHIBITION ON GAMING.*—*Any real prop-*  
20          *erty taken into trust under paragraph (1) shall not*  
21          *be eligible, or used, for any gaming activity carried*  
22          *out under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act (25*  
23          *U.S.C. 2701 et seq.).”.*
