CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for the lying in state of the remains of Ralph Puckett, Jr., the last Medal of Honor recipient for acts performed during the Korean conflict.

3 **SECTION 1. HONORING THE LAST MEDAL OF HONOR RE-**
4 **CIPIENT OF THE KOREAN CONFLICT.**

5 (a) USE OF ROTUNDA.—In recognition of Army Colo-
6 nel Ralph Puckett, Jr., the last recipient of the Medal of
7 Honor for acts performed during the Korean conflict, his

1 remains shall be permitted to lie in state in the rotunda
2 of the Capitol on April 29, 2024, in order to honor the
3 Silent Generation and the more than 5,700,000 men and
4 women who served in the Armed Forces of the United
5 States during the “Forgotten War” from 1950 to 1953.

6 (b) IMPLEMENTATION.—The Architect of the Capitol,
7 under the direction of the Speaker of the House of Rep-
8 resentatives and the President pro tempore of the Senate,
9 shall take all necessary steps to carry out this section.
