Mr. JONES (for himself and Mr. MASSIE) submitted the following resolution;
which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Raising a question of the privileges of the House.

Whereas H.R. 1123, the Unlocking Consumer Choice and Wireless Competition Act, was introduced on March 13, 2013;

Whereas the Committee on the Judiciary marked up and ordered the bill reported, with strong bipartisan support, on July 31, 2013;

Whereas the suspension version of the bill included new language to prohibit the bulk unlocking of cellular phones;

Whereas the changes made to the bill fundamentally altered the substance of the underlying bill;

Whereas the report of the Committee on the Judiciary on the bill was filed in the House on February 25, 2014; and

Whereas the bill was passed under suspension of the rules on
the night of February 25, 2014: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives dis-
2 approves of the actions taken by the Committee on the
3 Judiciary and the leadership of the House of Representa-
4 tives with respect to H.R. 1123 and directs the leadership
5 of each committee of the House and the leadership of the
6 House to operate in a matter that maximizes transparency
7 and public trust.
