To authorize improvements to flood damage reduction facilities adjacent to the American and Sacramento Rivers near Sacramento, California, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Natomas Basin Flood
5 Protection Improvements Act of 2013”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROJECT MODIFICATION, AMERICAN AND SAC-**
7 **RAMENTO RIVERS, CALIFORNIA.**

8 The project for flood damage reduction, American
9 and Sacramento Rivers, California, authorized by section

1 101(a)(1) of the Water Resources Development Act of
2 1996 (Public Law 104–303; 110 Stat. 3662; 113 Stat.
3 319; 117 Stat. 1839; 121 Stat. 1947), is modified to au-
4 thorize the Secretary of the Army, acting through the
5 Chief of Engineers, to construct improvements to flood
6 damage reduction facilities adjacent to the American and
7 Sacramento Rivers in the vicinity of Sacramento, Cali-
8 fornia, substantially in accordance with the report of the
9 Chief of Engineers entitled “American River Watershed
10 (Common Features) Project, Natomas Basin, Sacramento
11 and Sutter Counties, California”, and dated December 30,
12 2010, at an estimated total cost of \$1,389,500,000, with
13 an estimated Federal cost of \$921,200,000 and an esti-
14 mated non-Federal cost of \$468,300,000.

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
