## A BILL

To direct the Architect of the Capitol to place a chair honoring American Prisoners of War/Missing in Action on the Capitol Grounds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FINDINGS.**

4 The Congress finds the following:

5 (1) In recent years, commemorative chairs hon-  
6 oring American Prisoners of War/Missing in Action  
7 have been placed in prominent locations across the  
8 United States.

1           (2) The United States Capitol Grounds are an  
2           appropriate location to place a commemorative chair  
3           honoring American Prisoners of War/Missing in Ac-  
4           tion.

5 **SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF A CHAIR HONORING AMERICAN**  
6                           **PRISONERS OF WAR/MISSING IN ACTION ON**  
7                           **THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL GROUNDS.**

8           (a) **OBTAINING CHAIR.**—The Architect of the Capitol  
9           shall enter into an agreement to obtain a chair featuring  
10          the logo of the National League of POW/MIA Families  
11          under such terms and conditions as the Architect con-  
12          siders appropriate and consistent with applicable law.

13          (b) **PLACEMENT.**—Not later than 2 years after the  
14          date of enactment of this Act, the Architect shall place  
15          the chair obtained under subsection (a) on the United  
16          States Capitol Grounds in a suitable permanent location.

17 **SEC. 3. FUNDING.**

18          (a) **DONATIONS.**—The Architect of the Capitol  
19          may—

20                (1) enter into an agreement with any organiza-  
21                tion described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal  
22                Revenue Code of 1986 that is exempt from taxation  
23                under section 501(a) of that Code to solicit private  
24                donations to carry out the purposes of this Act; and

1           (2) accept donations of funds, property, and  
2           services to carry out the purposes of this Act.

3           (b) COSTS.—All costs incurred in carrying out the  
4 purposes of this Act shall be paid for with private dona-  
5 tions received under subsection (a).
