A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the Emergency Medical Services for Children Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Medical
5 Services for Children Reauthorization Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 Section 1910(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42
3 U.S.C. 300w-9(d)) is amended by striking “fiscal year
4 2014” and inserting “each of fiscal years 2015 through
5 2019”.

6 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

7 *This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Medical
8 Services for Children Reauthorization Act of 2014”.*

9 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

10 *Section 1910(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42
11 U.S.C. 300w-9(d)) is amended—*

12 *(1) by striking “and \$30,387,656” and inserting
13 “\$30,387,656”; and*

14 *(2) by inserting before the period “, and
15 \$20,213,000 for each of fiscal years 2015 through
16 2019”.*
