A BILL

To amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to include the Corps of Engineers as a Federal land management agency, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Corps of Engineers
5 Recreation Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 (a) DEFINITIONS.—Section 802 of the Federal Lands
8 Recreation Enhancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6801) is amend-
9 ed—

1 (1) in paragraph (4), by inserting “the Corps of
2 Engineers,” after “Bureau of Reclamation,”;

3 (2) in paragraph (10)—

4 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking
5 “and” after the semicolon;

6 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking the
7 period at the end and inserting “; and”; and

8 (C) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(C) the Secretary of the Army, with re-
10 spect to the Corps of Engineers.”; and

11 (3) in paragraph (11), by inserting “, the Sec-
12 retary of the Army,” after “Interior”.

13 (b) RECREATION FEE AUTHORITY.—Section 803 of
14 the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act (16
15 U.S.C. 6802) is amended—

16 (1) in subsection (d)(1), in the matter pre-
17 ceding subparagraph (A), by inserting “the Corps of
18 Engineers,” after “Forest Service,”;

19 (2) in subsection (f), in the matter preceding
20 paragraph (1), by inserting “the Corps of Engi-
21 neers,” after “Reclamation,”; and

22 (3) in subsection (g)(2), in the matter pre-
23 ceding subparagraph (A), by inserting “the Corps of
24 Engineers,” after “Land Management,”.

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
