

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0019

Low voltage electrical licensing-communications.

Sponsored by: Joint Corporations, Elections and Political  
Subdivisions Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to electrical licensing; creating exemption  
2 from licensing for low voltage installations as specified;  
3 changing archaic language; and providing for an effective  
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-9-123(a)(iv) and by creating a new  
9 paragraph (x) is amended to read:

10

11 **35-9-123. Electrical installations to be performed by**  
12 **licensed electricians; exceptions.**

13

14 (a) Licensed electrical contractors employing  
15 licensed master or journeymen electricians, or registered  
16 apprentice electricians supervised by a licensed master or

1 journeyman electrician shall install all electrical  
2 equipment. This requirement is waived for the following,  
3 however the waiver does not exempt the following persons  
4 from meeting all other code requirements under this act:

5

6 (iv) Cable-TV, satellite-TV and  
7 telecommunications, including data and related services of  
8 cable-TV, satellite-TV and telecommunications providers  
9 including its contractors and subcontractors provided ~~such~~  
10 the contractors and subcontractors are limited to the  
11 installation of low voltage cable, A.M. or F.M. radio  
12 stations, television stations, phone services, internet  
13 services, data services and related services;

14

15 (x) Low voltage installations, including  
16 hardware and cabling, of cable-TV, satellite-TV, sound  
17 systems, A.M. or F.M. radio services, television service,  
18 internet service and telecommunications services, including  
19 data and related services.

20

21 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
