for

- 1 AN ACT relating to public health; extending the critical 2 access/rural hospital endowment challenge program as 3 specified; amending qualifications for receipt of funds;
- 4 modifying reversion dates; making conforming amendments;
- 5 repealing obsolete provisions; and providing for an
- 6 effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-1-1002(a)(ii)(A), (B), by creating
- 11 a new subparagraph (C), (iii)(A), (B) and (vi),
- 12 35-1-1003(a) and (d) and 35-1-1004(h) are amended to read:

14 **35-1-1002.** Definitions.

1 (a) As used in this article: 2 3 (ii) "Critical access or rural hospital" means: 4 5 (A) A county hospital established pursuant to W.S. 18-8-101, et seq., or a special district hospital 6 established pursuant to W.S. 35-2-401, et seq., that is 7 8 certified to receive cost-based reimbursement from Medicare 9 or has forty (40) beds or less; or 10 11 (B) A hospital that is certified to receive 12 cost-based reimbursement from Medicare or has forty (40) 13 beds or less which is owned by a private not for profit 14 entity and is operated in a county in this state in which 15 hospital meeting the requirements of there is no 16 subparagraph (A) of this paragraph; - or 17 18 (C) A rural health care district 19 established under W.S. 35-2-701 through 35-2-709 in which 20 there is no hospital meeting the requirements of 21 subparagraph (A) or (B) of this paragraph. 22

22	(a) Four million dollars (\$4,000,000.00) is
23	appropriated from the general fund to the critical access

1	or rural hospital endowment challenge account as created
2	under section 1 of this act. Of this appropriation, not
3	more than two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall be
4	transferred to the challenge account as necessary during
5	the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June
6	30, 2008. The remaining funds shall be transferred to the
7	challenge account as necessary during the fiscal period
8	beginning July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009.
9	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any unexpended
10	funds in excess of one million five hundred thousand
11	dollars (\$1,500,000.00) from the amount appropriated under
12	this subsection shall revert to the budget reserve account
13	on June 30, 2012. Any remaining funds in the account shall
14	revert to the budget reserve account on June 30, 2015.
15	
16	Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
17	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
18	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
19	Constitution.
