A BILL

for

- AN ACT relating to water; providing for the perfection and 1
- 2 appropriation of surface waters located on federal lands as
- specified; providing for the perfection and appropriation 3
- underground waters located on federal 4 lands
- specified; identifying the owner of a water right issued on 5
- federal lands as specified; restricting the holding of a 6
- water right on federal land as specified; and providing for 7

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10

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Section 1. W.S. 41-3-116 is created to read: 12

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- 14 issued on 41-3-116. Water rights federal lands;
- 15 identification of the water right owner.

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1 (a) Pursuant to W.S. 41-3-101, the permitting and

2 appropriations of water for stock use, or stock and

3 wildlife use jointly, with a point of appropriation on

4 federal lands shall be issued in the name of the holder or

5 holders of a valid permit to graze livestock issued by the

6 appropriate federal land management agency.

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8 (b) Where livestock grazing is allowed on federal

9 land but no grazing permit is issued by a federal land

10 management agency, any water right issued to support the

11 livestock grazing may be issued in the name of any

12 subdivision of state government, local government, state

13 established special district, livestock association or

14 grazing board that can provide for beneficial use of the

15 water pursuant to W.S. 41-3-101.

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17 (c) Whereas wildlife is the property of the state, no

18 person other than the state of Wyoming or any subdivision

19 of state government, local government or established

20 special district that can provide for beneficial use of the

21 water shall own a water right on federal lands where the

22 intended water use solely benefits wildlife, wildlife

23 habitat or environmental purposes pursuant to W.S.

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24 41-3-101.

domestic use, the latter being defined as household use and

the watering of lawns and gardens for noncommercial family

1 use where the area to be irrigated does not exceed one (1)

2 acre, where the yield or flow does not exceed .056 cubic

3 feet per second or twenty-five (25) gallons per minute,

4 shall have a preferred right over rights for all other

5 uses, regardless of their dates of priority, subject to the

6 provisions of W.S. 41-3-911, as amended, if an

appropriation is for two (2) or more uses, and includes one

8 (1) of the above preferred uses, the preferred use shall be

9 limited to .056 cubic feet per second or twenty-five (25)

10 gallons per minute, and the application shall specify one

11 (1) acre upon which such preferred uses shall be made. Such

12 preferred use shall not include municipal use by any person

13 of water appropriated by a municipality or company, or any

14 instance where water is purchased or held out for sale.

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16 (b) Pursuant to W.S. 41-3-101, the permitting and

17 appropriations of underground water for stock use, or stock

6 the water pursuant to W.S. 41-3-101.

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9 (d) Whereas wildlife is the property of the state, no

10 person other than the state of Wyoming or any subdivision

11 of state government, local government or established

12 special district that can provide for beneficial use of the

13 water shall own an underground water right on federal lands

14 where the intended water use solely benefits wildlife,

wildlife habitat or environmental purposes pursuant to W.S.

16 41-3-101.

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18 (e) Nothing in this section shall be construed to

19 require the owner of an underground water right on federal

20 land to maintain federally constructed facilities, works or

21 infrastructure necessary for the issuance of a water right

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22 under this section.

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24 (f) For the purposes of this section:

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2 <u>(i) A feral horse under federal jurisdiction</u>

3 shall not be considered stock; and

4

5 (ii) A federal land management agency shall not

6 <u>be considered a holder of a valid permit to graze livestock</u>

7 on federal land.

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9 **Section 3**. This act is effective immediately upon

10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

12 Constitution.
