2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 33.05.040 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (b) The caseload of a probation officer supervising probationers or the 5 combined caseload of a probation officer or parole officer supervising probationers 6 and persons on parole as provided for in (a)(5) of this section may not exceed 60 7 persons, except in temporary or extraordinary circumstances approved by the 8 commissioner.
