# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to accrual of service in the public employees' retirement system by a 2 peace officer or firefighter while the peace officer or firefighter is unable to work and is 3 receiving workers' compensation benefits; and requiring the state to make certain 4 contributions under the defined contribution plan of the public employees' retirement 5 system for a peace officer or firefighter who is unable to work and is receiving workers' 6 compensation benefits." 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA: 8 \* Section 1. AS 39.35.330 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 9 (e) Notwithstanding (b) of this section, a peace officer or firefighter who takes 10 a leave of absence without pay because the peace officer or firefighter is unable to 11 work because of an on-the-job injury or occupational illness for which the peace 12 officer or firefighter is receiving benefits under AS 23.30 is entitled to accrue credited
