- FISHERY, A] salmon seine vessel may not be longer than 58 feet overall length
- 7 [EXCEPT VESSELS THAT HAVE FISHED FOR SALMON WITH SEINES IN
- 8 WATERS OF THE STATE BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1962, AS 50-FOOT, OFFICIAL
- 9 COAST GUARD REGISTER LENGTH VESSELS].
