FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act providing an increase and an inflation adjustment to the base student
- 2 allocation used in the formula for state funding of public education; requiring a review
- 3 and recommendation for future adjustments to the base student allocation; and
- 4 providing for an effective date."
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * **Section 1.** AS 14.17.470 is amended to read:
- 7 **Sec. 14.17.470. Base student allocation.** The base student allocation is **\$5,838**
- 8 [\$5,680].
- * Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
- 10 read:
- 11 BASE STUDENT ALLOCATION; ADJUSTMENT; STUDY AND
- 12 RECOMMENDATIONS. The Department of Education and Early Development shall, for
- 13 fiscal years 2013 and 2014,
- 14 (1) annually adjust the base student allocation to reflect an inflation

- 1 adjustment based on the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers for the Anchorage
- 2 metropolitan area compiled by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United States Department of
- 3 Labor; the index for January 2010 is the reference base index;
- 4 (2) conduct a review of the actual changes in educational cost per student for
- 5 each district; and
- 6 (3) on or before January 10, 2014, provide a recommendation to the 28th
- 7 Legislature for the amount and adjustment of the base student allocation beginning in fiscal
- 8 year 2015.
- 9 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
