- with the state fire marshal as a member of a volunteer fire department; or

- * Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
- 14 read:

1 APPLICABILITY. The presumption of coverage established by this Act applies to 2 claims made on or after the effective date of this Act, even if the exposure leading to the occupational disease occurred before the effective date of this Act. 3
