## A BILL

# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act extending the school term; and providing for an effective date."

# 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- Sec. 14.03.030. School term. A school term begins and ends on the dates fixed by the governing body of a school district. A school term shall include not less than 190 [180] days in session unless, with the approval of the commissioner,

  (1) a day used for in-service training of teachers is substituted for a day in session, up to a maximum of 10 days;
  - (2) an "emergency closure day" is substituted for a day in session because of conditions posing a threat to the health or safety of students; or
  - (3) the school board adopts a different school term that includes at least <u>780</u> [740] hours of instruction and study periods for pupils in kindergarten <u>and</u> [,] first grade [, SECOND GRADE, AND THIRD GRADE] and at least <u>1,000</u> [900] hours of instruction and study periods for pupils in grades <u>two</u> [FOUR] through 12 if the commissioner finds that the school board has submitted an acceptable plan under
