### A BILL

# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the chair of the Regulatory Commission of Alaska."

## 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- **\* Section 1.** AS 42.04.010(b) is amended to read:
- 4 (b) The governor shall designate one member of the commission [SHALL 5 ANNUALLY ELECT ONE OF ITS MEMBERS] to serve as chair [FOR THE
- 6 FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR]. When a vacancy occurs in the office of chair, the
- 7 **governor shall designate one of the members of** the commission [SHALL ELECT
- 8 ONE OF ITS MEMBERS] to serve the remaining term as chair. The term as chair is
- 9 <u>three years</u> [ONE YEAR. THE CHAIR MAY BE ELECTED TO NOT MORE
- THAN THREE SUCCESSIVE TERMS AS CHAIR. AFTER A YEAR OF NOT
- 11 SERVING AS CHAIR, THE COMMISSIONER IS ELIGIBLE FOR ELECTION AS
- 12 CHAIR AGAIN].
- \* Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
- 14 read:
- 15 TRANSITION. Notwithstanding AS 42.04.010(b), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act,

- 1 the chair of the Regulatory Commission of Alaska on the day before the effective date of this
- 2 Act may continue to serve as chair until the end of that person's term as chair as that term
- 3 existed on the day before the effective date of this Act.
