A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act establishing a license and temporary license for an associate social worker;
- 2 relating to the exemption of certain persons from licensure as social workers; and
- 3 relating to the reinstatement of lapsed social worker licenses."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 5 * **Section 1.** AS 08.95.010(a) is amended to read:
- 6 (a) There is created the Board of Social Work Examiners composed of five 7 members, as follows: one member licensed under this chapter as an associate 8 social worker; one member licensed under this chapter as a baccalaureate social 9 worker; one member licensed under this chapter as a master social worker; one 10 member [TWO MEMBERS] licensed under this chapter as a clinical social worker 11 [WORKERS]; and one public member who has never been licensed under this 12 chapter. At least one of the licensed members must be a person who is not an 13 employee of a federal, state, or local government.
