- 28 (e) Section 5 of this Act takes effect only if the legislature appropriates at least \$10,000,000 but less than \$15,000,000 as grants to school districts for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, for distribution according to the average daily membership for each district adjusted under AS 14.17.410(b)(1)(A) (D).

- 1 (f) Section 6 of this Act takes effect only if the legislature appropriates less than
- 2 \$10,000,000 as grants to school districts for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, for
