## FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to a voluntary preference for veterans by private employers."

# 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 \* **Section 1.** AS 18.80.200 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 4 (c) Nothing in this chapter is intended to prohibit a private employer from 5 granting an employment preference to a veteran when hiring an employee. In this 6 subsection, "veteran" means a person who was honorably discharged from service in 7 (1) the armed forces of the United States; 8 (2) a reserve unit of the armed forces of the United States; 9 (3) the Alaska Territorial Guard; 10 (4) the Alaska Army National Guard; 11 (5) the Alaska Air National Guard; or 12 (6) the Alaska Naval Militia.

- 14 Chapter 55. Employment of Veterans.
- 15 Sec. 23.55.010. Veteran hiring preference allowed. A private employer may

1	grant an employment preference to a veteran when hiring an employee. In this section,

4	(2) a reserve unit of the armed forces of the United States;
5	(3) the Alaska Territorial Guard;
