FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to coercion; and relating to interference with constitutional rights."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 11.41.530(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A person commits the crime of coercion if, under circumstances not 5 proscribed under AS 11.41.410 - 11.41.427, the person compels another to engage in 6 conduct from which there is a legal right to abstain or abstain from conduct in which 7 there is a legal right to engage, by means of instilling in the person who is compelled a 8 fear that, if the demand is not complied with, the person who makes the demand or 9 another may

(1) inflict physical injury on anyone, except under circumstances
 constituting robbery in any degree, or commit any other crime;

(2) accuse anyone of a crime;

(3) expose confidential information or a secret, whether true or false,
tending to subject a person to hatred, contempt, or ridicule or to impair the person's
credit or business repute;
