FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act reducing the membership of the Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry 2 Commission to two individuals; providing that a single commissioner may exercise all 3 powers and duties of the commission if there is a vacancy on the commission; providing 4 for commissioner compensation; relating to tie votes of the commission; and providing 5 for an effective date."

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 * Section 1. AS 16.43.020(a) is amended to read:

(a) There is established the Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission 9 as a regulatory and quasi-judicial agency of the state. The commission consists of two 10 [THREE] members appointed by the governor and confirmed by the legislature in
