# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to insurance coverage for mental health benefits provided through
- 2 telemedicine."

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* **Section 1.** AS 21.42 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- 5 Sec. 21.42.422. Coverage for telemedicine and mental health benefits. A
- 6 health care insurer that offers, issues for delivery, or renews in the state a health care
- 7 insurance plan in the group or individual market that provides mental health benefits
- 8 shall provide coverage for mental health benefits provided through telemedicine by a
- 9 health care provider licensed in this state and may not require that prior in-person
- 10 contact occur between a health care provider and a patient before payment is made for
- 11 covered services.
- \* Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
- 13 read:
- 14 APPLICABILITY. AS 21.42.422, added by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to a health care

- 1 insurance plan offered, issued for delivery, delivered, or renewed on or after the effective date
- 2 of this Act.
