3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 44.99 is amended by adding a new section to article 1 to read:
- Sec. 44.99.050. Prohibition on requiring medical procedures. (a) A person that receives state funds may not enact or enforce a policy requiring an employee or contractor of the person to receive a medical procedure.
- 8 (b) If a person enacts a policy requiring an employee or contractor to receive a
 9 medical procedure, the person is not eligible to receive state funds while the policy is
 10 in effect.
- 11 (c) In this section,
- 12 (1) "contractor" has the meaning given in AS 23.30.045(f);
- 13 (2) "employee" has the meaning given in AS 18.60.105(a).
