A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to breaks for employees who are nursing mothers."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 23.10 is amended by adding a new section to article 7 to read:
- Sec. 23.10.450. Nursing mothers. (a) An employer shall provide reasonable unpaid break time during the work day to an employee who is a nursing mother so that the employee may breastfeed or express breast milk. The break time must occur at intervals that reasonably ensure the health and comfort of the mother and her child and allow the employee to maintain breast milk supply, and may run concurrently with other break time provided to the employee.
 - (b) An employer shall provide a private and sanitary space located near the employee's work area where the employee can breastfeed or express breast milk. The space may not be a toilet stall.
 - (c) Nothing in this section requires an employer to allow a child to be present in a workplace at times other than break times.
 - (d) In this section, "employer" means a person that has one or more
