FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to coercion; and relating to interference with constitutional rights."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4	(a) A person commits the crime of coercion if the person compels another to
5	engage in conduct from which there is a legal right to abstain or abstain from conduct
6	in which there is a legal right to engage, by means of instilling in the person who is
7	compelled a fear that, if the demand is not complied with, the person who makes the
8	demand or another may
9	(1) inflict physical injury on anyone, except under circumstances
10	constituting robbery in any degree, or commit any other crime;
11	(2) accuse anyone of a crime;
12	(3) expose confidential information or a secret, whether true or false,
13	tending to subject a person to hatred, contempt, or ridicule or to impair the person's
14	credit or business repute;
15	(4) take or withhold action as a public servant or cause a public servant
