FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- *** Section 1.** AS 44.99.040(a) is amended to read:
- 5 (a) A state or municipal agency may not use or authorize the use of an asset to implement or aid in the implementation of a requirement of
- 7 (1) an order of the President of the United States, a federal regulation, 8 or a law enacted by the United States Congress that is applied to
- 9 (A) infringe on a person's right, under the Second Amendment 10 to the Constitution of the United States, to keep and bear arms;
- 11 (B) deny a person a right to due process, or a protection of due 12 process, that would otherwise be available to the person under the Constitution 13 of the State of Alaska or the Constitution of the United States;
- 14 (C) infringe on a person's right to move freely in the state
