FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the foster care independent living transition program; and

2 establishing and relating to the foster care independent living transition program fund."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
5 to read:

LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The legislature intends to appropriate, during fiscal year
2016, an amount equal to \$500,000 to the foster care independent living transition program
fund established under AS 47.18.320(a), as amended by sec. 3 of this Act.
