**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act exempting the state from daylight saving time; and providing for an effective**  
2 **date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Article 5. Standard Time.**

6 **Sec. 44.12.400. Exemption from daylight saving time.** The state exempts  
7 itself from observation of advanced time, also known as daylight saving time, between  
8 2:00 a.m. on the second Sunday in March and 2:00 a.m. on the first Sunday in  
9 November in each calendar year, and the entire state shall observe the standard time  
10 that is otherwise applicable during that period.

11 **\* Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
