# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to the release of certain records of convictions; and providing for an
- 2 effective date."

### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* **Section 1.** AS 12.62.160 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 5 (f) Notwithstanding (b)(8) of this section, the department may not release 6 records of a criminal case if the defendant
- 7 (1) applies to the department on a form provided by the department;
- 8 (2) was convicted under AS 11.71.060, or a municipal ordinance with 9 similar elements, for possession of less than one ounce of a schedule VIA controlled 10 substance;
- 11 (3) was 21 years of age or older at the time of commission of the offense; and
- 13 (4) had all other criminal charges acquitted or dismissed in the case by 14 the prosecuting authority and were not dismissed as part of a plea agreement in
