A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act requiring school districts to provide a plan for hiring principals of excellence;
- 2 relating to identifying and recognizing principals of excellence; relating to adjusting the
- 3 base student allocation used in the formula for state funding of public education to
- 4 account for education staff losses since fiscal year 2011 and to account for inflation in
- 5 the future; and providing for an effective date."

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
- 8 to read:
- 9 BASE STUDENT ALLOCATION ADJUSTMENT: LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE. The
- base student allocation has not been increased since fiscal year 2011 to account for future
- inflation. In 2014, the legislature is working on the fiscal year 2015 budget. The purpose of
- 12 secs. 4 and 5 of this Act is to avoid a loss of public education funding caused by inflation
- 13 rates in the state.
