STATE OF ALASKA 2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill requires the department to adopt assessment standards consistent with those of the International Association of Assessing Officers. Under this bill, assessors shall be required to determine the full and true value of property using standards adopted by the department or by standards provided by ordinance. This bill requires an assessor with a municipality to hold a level 3 certification from the Alaska Association of Assessing Officers, or work under the supervision of someone with this certification; and requires the municipal governing body to appoint one or more boards of equalization when hearing an appeal of a determination made by an assessor, with the board comprised of at least three people.

The Division of Community and Regional Affairs will need to update regulations to reflect the changes in this legislation, as well as notify the public of the changes. Legal costs and the costs associated with the regulation update will be absorbed by the division's existing budget.
