A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to airport security screening pat-down searches."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 02.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 02.15.235. Witness present during security screening pat-down**
5 **search.** A person who is subject to an airport security screening private pat-down
6 search may request that a witness of the person's choosing be present at the private
7 pat-down search. The witness may be a police officer employed by the state or a
8 political subdivision of the state. The security screening personnel may not refuse the
9 request for a witness to be present at a private pat-down search.
