**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to employment by a legislator or legislative body of a person who has**  
2 **been formerly employed by the Legislative Affairs Agency as an attorney."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 24.60.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (k) A legislator, caucus, or legislative body may not employ a person who was  
6 formerly employed as a nonpartisan attorney by the Legislative Affairs Agency for a  
7 period of one year after the person leaves employment with the Legislative Affairs  
8 Agency. In this subsection, "caucus" and "legislative body" have the meanings given  
9 in AS 24.60.037.
