### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* **Section 1.** AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- 5 Article 17. Computer Science Program.
  - Sec. 14.30.850. Computer science program. (a) Each school district that provides educational services within a juvenile facility shall establish and provide to students in the juvenile facility, to the maximum extent practicable, an opportunity to access a computer science program approved by the department. A school district may provide the program through one or more courses offered by the school district, but the program's hours of instruction must in the aggregate be equivalent to a one-half credit hour course. A school district may provide the program through telecommunications or other digital or electronic methods.
    - (b) Each school district that provides educational services within a juvenile

facility shall annually report to the commissioner data on the percentage of students
who are enrolled in, have partially completed, or have completed the program. The
data must be separated by a student's gender, age, and eligibility for free or reduced-
price meals under 42 U.S.C. 1751 - 1769j (National School Lunch Act). If a
technology security limitation or juvenile facility limitation prevents the school district
from providing the program to students in the juvenile facility, the report must include
a brief description of the limitation and the actions the school district and juvenile
facility are taking to address the limitation.
(c) In this section,
(1) "juvenile facility" means a juvenile detention facility or juvenile

- (2) "program" means the computer science program established in this section;
  - (3) "school district" has the meaning given in AS 14.30.350.
