### **A BILL**

## FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the special sessions of the Alaska State Legislature."

#### 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 \* **Section 1.** AS 24.05.100(b) is amended to read:
  - (b) A special session may be held at any location in the state. If a special session called under (a)(1) of this section is to be convened at a location other than at the capital, the governor shall designate the location in the proclamation. If a special session called under (a)(2) of this section is to be convened at a location other than at the capital, the presiding officers shall agree to and designate the location in the poll conducted of the members of both houses. A special session called under (a)(2) of this section within 90 days after the adjournment of a regular session may not be designated or convened in the capital.
