1 **"An Act relating to the special sessions of the Alaska State Legislature."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 24.05.100(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) A special session may be held at any location in the state. If a special
5 session called under (a)(1) of this section is to be convened at a location other than at
6 the capital, the governor shall designate the location in the proclamation. If a special
7 session called under (a)(2) of this section is to be convened at a location other than at
8 the capital, the presiding officers shall agree to and designate the location in the poll
9 conducted of the members of both houses. **A special session called under (a)(2) of**
10 **this section within 90 days after the adjournment of a regular session may not be**
11 **designated or convened in the capital.**
