1 "An Act relating to the development of certain state land subject to a permit, right-of-

2 way, or easement for public use and recreation."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 38.05.850 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

5 (d) If the director issues a permit, right-of-way, or easement on state land for a 6 road, field gathering line or transmission and distribution pipeline not subject to 7 AS 38.35, telephone or electric transmission and distribution line, or another similar 8 use or improvement under this section, the commissioner shall retain for the land 9 subject to the permit, right-of-way, or easement the right of the public to use and have 10 free access to the land for recreational purposes if the permit, right-of-way, or 11 easement

(1) is compatible with development of the land for public recreation;

13 (2) is of sufficient size to accommodate development of the land for14 multiple uses; and

(3) can be developed for public recreational use at no cost to the
 person who is issued the permit, right-of-way, or easement.

(e) If the permit, right-of-way, or easement meets the requirements of (d) of
this section, the department shall solicit proposals for trail development and
maintenance from agencies or third parties to develop the land subject to the permit,
right-of-way, or easement for recreational purposes. The developing agency or party
shall fund the development and maintenance costs incurred under this subsection.
