A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act changing certain limitations set out in the Alaska Executive Branch Ethics Act**
2 **applicable to employment relationships between state employees who are related to each**
3 **other as immediate family members."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 39.52.910(d) is repealed and reenacted to read:

6 (d) Nothing in this chapter

7 (1) supersedes AS 39.90.020; or

8 (2) precludes a person from being in an employment relationship with
9 a member of the person's immediate family if the person

10 (A) does not supervise the immediate family member; or

11 (B) supervises the immediate family member but exercise of
12 the supervision is only routine; under this subparagraph, supervision is routine
13 only if, as to a decision that requires the person's exercise of independent
14 judgment, the person may not act or recommend the family member's

- 1 (i) appointment to employment, including hiring,
- 2 transferring, laying off, and recalling;
- 3 (ii) discipline, including suspension, discharge,
- 4 demotion, and issuance of written warnings; or
- 5 (iii) grievance adjudication, including responding to a
- 6 first level grievance under a collective bargaining agreement.
