FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to the exhibition of marked ballots and the prohibition on political

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * **Section 1.** AS 15.15.170 is amended to read:
- Sec. 15.15.170. Prohibition of political persuasion near election polls. (a)

 During the hours the polls are open, a person who is in the polling place or within 200
- feet of any entrance to the polling place may not
- 8 (1) attempt to persuade a person to vote for or against a candidate,
- 9 proposition, or question; or
- 10 (2) physically display a photo, video, or other image of the person's
- or another person's marked ballot in an attempt to persuade a person to vote for
- or against a candidate, proposition, or question.
- 13 (b) The election officials shall post warning notices at the required distance in the form and manner prescribed by the director.
