Making appropriations for the operating and capital expenses of the state's integrated
 comprehensive mental health program; and providing for an effective date.

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(SECTION 1 OF THIS ACT BEGINS ON PAGE 2)

Section 1. The following appropriation items are for operating expenditures from the general fund or other funds as set out in section 2 of this Act to the agencies named for the purposes expressed for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016, unless otherwise indicated. A department-wide, agency-wide, or branch-wide unallocated reduction set out in this section may be allocated among the appropriations made in this section to that department, agency, or branch.

1 \* Sec. 7. PURPOSE. In accordance with AS 37.14.003 and 37.14.005, the appropriations made in this Act are for the state's integrated comprehensive mental health program. 2

3 \* Sec. 8. NONGENERAL FUND RECEIPTS. (a) Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority 4 authorized receipts (AS 37.14.036) or administration receipts (AS 37.14.036) that exceed the 5 amounts appropriated in this Act are appropriated conditioned on compliance with the 6 program review provisions of AS 37.07.080(h).

(b) If Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority authorized receipts (AS 37.14.036) or 8 administration receipts (AS 37.14.036) fall short of the estimates used as the basis of the 9 appropriation, the affected appropriation is reduced by the amount of the shortfall in receipts.

10 \* Sec. 9. MONETARY TERMS OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS. The 11 monetary terms for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, of each of the collective bargaining 12 agreements listed in this section are rejected under AS 23.40.215 unless separate legislation is 13 enacted that contains explicit language approving the monetary terms of that agreement. 14 Money appropriated in sec. 1 of this Act may not be used to implement the monetary terms 15 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, of any of the collective bargaining agreements listed 16 in this section unless separate legislation is enacted that contains explicit language approving 17 the monetary terms of the collective bargaining agreement. This section applies to the 18 collective bargaining agreements negotiated between the state and the following bargaining 19 organizations:
