Establishing the second Monday of October of each year as Indigenous Peoples Day.

**Section 1. AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

**Sec. 44.12.150. Indigenous Peoples Day. Indigenous Peoples Day is established on the second Monday of October of each year. Indigenous Peoples Day may be observed by suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
