- 4 travel allowances for use of the governor's personal residence.

- That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
- Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding
- 8 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of Senate Bill No. 244, providing
- 9 that, during the governor's term of office, the duty station of the governor is Juneau, and
- prohibiting payment of certain travel allowances for use of the governor's personal residence.
