A RESOLUTION

- 1 Suspending Rules 20, 21(c), 23(a), and 24(a), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State
- 2 Legislature, relating to measures in possession of standing committees and special
- 3 committees of the house of representatives, for the purpose of restricting committee
- 4 meetings of the house of representatives to measures that substantially relate to and
- 5 have as their primary purpose appropriating, raising, or allocating state revenue, until
- 6 the house of representatives passes a state operating budget to the senate.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 8 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
- 9 (1) Rule 23(a), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding both
- 10 the preceding Thursday notice requirement and the five-day notice requirement for a person
- who chairs a standing or special committee of the house of representatives, is suspended until
- 12 the house of representatives passes a state operating budget to the senate; the person who
- chairs a standing or special committee of the house of representatives shall post written notice
- of the time, place, and subject matter of meetings at least 24 hours before the meeting; and
