**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Establishing a House Special Committee on Economic Development, Trade, and**  
2 **Tourism.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

4 **WHEREAS** economic development is of vital importance to the economy of the state;  
5 and

6 **WHEREAS** tourism is of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and

7 **WHEREAS** the legislature should remain well informed about the business climate of  
8 the state; and

9 **WHEREAS** the state must promote business opportunities within the state;

10 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee  
11 on Economic Development, Trade, and Tourism is established to study trade, tourism, and  
12 opportunities for future economic development of the state's resources; and be it

13 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall  
14 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint  
15 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

16 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House Special Committee on Economic
