A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to questionnaires and surveys administered in the public schools."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 4 (a) Except as provided in (g) of this section, a [A] school district, principal or other person in charge of a public school, or teacher in a public school may not administer or permit to be administered in a school a questionnaire or survey, whether anonymous or not, that inquires into personal or private family affairs of the student
- not a matter of public record or subject to public observation unless written permission
- 9 is obtained from the student's parent or legal guardian.

26	denial of permission to take the survey.
