FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to immunity of persons who provide surveillance videos to law**
2 **enforcement agencies for law enforcement purposes."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 09.65.340. Civil liability for providing surveillance video to law**
6 **enforcement.** A person who conducts, as a security measure, video surveillance of the
7 person's property is not liable for civil damages if the person, without a search
8 warrant, allows a law enforcement officer to view that video or provides a copy of the
9 video to a law enforcement officer if the law enforcement officer requests the video to
10 assist with a criminal prosecution or to determine if a crime has been committed.
