FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to payment of legislator salaries; disapproving recommendations of the
- 2 State Officers Compensation Commission; and providing for an effective date."
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * **Section 1.** AS 24.10.120 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 5 (c) Upon request of a legislator, the legislator shall receive the legislator's total 6 salary for a calendar year before June 1 of that year. If the legislator, or the estate of 7 the legislator, receives the total salary, the legislator, or the estate of the legislator, is 8 indebted to the state on a pro rata basis for the time during the calendar year that the 9 legislator does not serve in office.
- * Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:
- DISAPPROVAL OF THE STATE OFFICERS COMPENSATION COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATIONS. Notwithstanding the 60-day time limit in AS 39.23.540(d), the
- 14 recommendations for governor, lieutenant governor, department head, and legislator salaries

- 1 contained in the final report of the State Officers Compensation Commission, as amended on
- 2 March 15, 2023, are disapproved.
- 3 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
