* **Section 1.** AS 28.35.161(a) is amended to read:

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 4 A person commits the crime of driving while texting, while 5 communicating on a computer, or while a screen device is operating if the person is
- 6 driving a motor vehicle on a highway or vehicular way in the state, and
- 7 (1) the vehicle has a television, video monitor, portable computer, or
- 8 any other similar means capable of providing a visual display that is in full view of a
- 9 driver in a normal driving position while the vehicle is in motion, and the monitor or
- 10 visual display is operating while the person is driving; or
- 11 (2) the person is reading or typing a text message or other nonvoice
- 12 message or communication on a cellular telephone, personal data assistant, computer,
- 13 or any other similar means capable of providing a visual display that is in the view of
- 14 the driver in a normal driving position except when the vehicle is
- (A) lawfully parked, standing, or stopped and is not in a 15
